Audit Scotland receives many information requests on a daily basis and we provide a wide range of information to people who contact us. We also proactively publish the results of our work in the form of reports for the Auditor General and the Accounts Commission and issue press releases on these. Additionally, a wide range of information is available through our publication scheme.

Some requests will be less straightforward to deal with and this log contains information which has been released in response to Freedom of Information (FOI) requests. The number of these requests will not reflect the true volume of requests we receive and the amount of information we routinely provide.
