

### Section 2 – Adult social work

Note: In view of the continuing development of the indicators for social work services, some of the indicators contained in this section may be considered to contain 'transitional' elements in accordance with the developed criteria (see Section 1). However, none have specifically been identified as 'transitional'.

#### Community care

- 1. The average time taken to provide community care services from first identification of need to first service provision.**

##### *What the indicator reports*

This indicator measures the efficiency of the council in providing community care services quickly to those who have been identified and assessed as being in need of them. The indicator applies to all people who have had a completed community care assessment and a service provided in the reporting year, including (but not restricted to) people who have had a "single shared assessment" led by health, housing, or voluntary sector staff.

The average time is measured as the MEDIAN time interval for service provision.

##### *Points to bear in mind*

This is the first year of reporting for this indicator which is a subset of data collated and published by the Scottish Executive (SE) at ([www.scotland.gov.uk/](http://www.scotland.gov.uk/) ).

The information relates only to cases assessed during the period October to December 2005 and is not a full year's data.

Following assessment of the data supplied to the SE, and comments from councils' appointed auditors, both the SE and Audit Scotland are satisfied that the extent to which councils were able to establish satisfactory systems to collect robust data varied significantly, particularly in relation to cases where assessment was undertaken by partner organisations. Therefore, great care is required when comparing the performance of councils based on this information.

#### Staff qualification

- 2. The percentage of care staff in care homes who have appropriate qualifications the level of post held, working council care homes for:**
  - older people (aged 65+)
  - other adults.

##### *What the indicator reports*

This indicator identifies the extent to which professional staff working in council care homes are appropriately qualified. The extent to which care staff have appropriate qualifications for the post they hold is one of a number of factors which contribute to the quality of residential care, but it is significant.

##### *Points to bear in mind*

Appropriate qualifications for care staff are established by the Scottish Social Services Council (SSSC). Professional staff working in care homes are required to register with the SSSC and to demonstrate that they hold appropriate qualification for the level of post they occupy. This indicator will be affected by:

- the availability of suitably qualified staff
- national guidance to councils on staff qualification from the SSSC.

## Adult social work

The indicator relates only to staff in care homes managed by councils. Voluntary and private sector homes are not included.

### Privacy in residential accommodation

- 3: **The number of single rooms and the number of rooms with en-suite facilities, expressed as a percentage of registered care places used by the council for each client group.**

#### ***What the indicator reports***

Research on the preferences of residents in residential establishments shows that privacy is of particular importance. Therefore, the indicator measures this particular aspect of the quality of the residential care.

The indicator is based on the number of bedrooms intended solely for one person, and excludes rooms which have two or more beds but are used by only one person.

En-suite facilities will have as a minimum a shower or bath in the apartment for the sole use of the resident, but it should be recognised that many homes, but not all, will provide a higher standard than this.

#### ***Points to bear in mind***

The indicator is likely to be affected by:

- limitations in the resources available to councils and the owners of homes in the voluntary and private sectors to improve homes by increasing the number of single rooms
- the physical layout of an existing home, which may limit the scope for creating single rooms
- design standards for new homes which encourage greater provision of single rooms

It is desirable for councils to retain some double rooms to accommodate married or cohabiting couples.

### Home care/Home helps

- 4: **a) The number of people age 65+ receiving homecare**  
**b) The number of homecare hours per 1,000 population age 65+**  
**c) As a proportion of home care clients age 65+, the number receiving:**
- personal care
  - a service during evenings/overnight
  - a service at weekends

#### ***What the indicator reports***

Home care is one of the most important services available to local authorities to support people with community care needs to remain at home. The indicator measures the overall volume of service for the largest client group, in terms of both the total number of clients and the total number of home care hours provided or purchased per 1,000 people age 65+.

## Adult social work

Increasing the flexibility of the service is a key policy objective for both central and local government, to ensure that people receive the type of assistance which they need, when they need it. The indicator measures flexibility in terms of the extent to which:

- care is provided outwith normal working hours to meet clients' needs
- personal care is provided, in addition to help with domestic tasks.

### **Points to bear in mind**

The indicator will be affected by:

- the pattern of need and demand within the council area, influenced by the age-structure of the elderly population, the distribution of poverty and ill health, household composition, and other factors
- the particular needs of people who receive the service
- the balance between home-based and residential care services in the council area.

The indicator only captures 'home care services' which are provided on an hourly basis. Other services which support people at home, such as laundry services, home shopping, community alarms and meals-on-wheels, are not included.

## Respite care

### 5: Provision of respite services:

### **What the indicator reports**

Respite care is a service intended to benefit a carer and the person he or she cares for by providing a short break from caring tasks. Breaks provided to people without carers are excluded from this performance indicator, which measures a key element of support for carers. This indicator only concerns respite care provided or purchased by the council, or by voluntary organisations funded for this purpose by the council.

Respite care breaks may last a few hours or a few weeks and may or may not be repeated at regular intervals. The duration of the service episode must allow the carer a break from caring tasks; for this reason a minimum duration of one hour is required for the service episode to count as respite for the purposes of this performance indicator (normally, the duration of the respite episode will be longer). The carer may use the break for any non-caring activity he or she chooses. Services that provide additional care alongside the care provided by the carer (to the same or another cared-for person) provide assistance but do not provide a respite break.

The indicator reports on both the volume of respite provided and the extent to which that respite is provided outwith 'institutional' settings for older people and other adults.

### **Points to bear in mind**

The indicator will be affected primarily by:

- the pattern of need and services required
- the availability of respite care.

### Social enquiry reports

- 6:      a) The number of social enquiry reports submitted to courts during the year  
          b) The proportion of these submitted by the due date

#### *What the indicator reports*

The first part of this indicator provides information about the volume of social enquiry work undertaken, while the second part measures the efficiency of the service provided in terms of the proportion of cases which meet the timescales for the key social work actions set out in the 'National Objectives and Standards for Social Work in the Criminal Justice System'.

#### *Points to bear in mind*

All Social Enquiry Reports submitted to courts during the reporting year, including pre-trial reports are included.

### Probation

- 7:      a) The number of new probation orders issued during the year  
          b) The proportion of new probationers seen by a supervising officer within one week.

#### *What the indicator reports*

The first part of this indicator provides information about the volume of probation work undertaken, while the second part measures the efficiency of the service.

#### *Points to bear in mind*

The proportion of probationers seen within a week of the order being made will be adversely affected by probationers not attending scheduled appointments and by late notifications of Orders by the courts

### Community service

- 8:      a) The number of new community service orders issued during the year  
          b) The average number of hours per week taken to complete orders.

#### *What the indicator reports*

The first part of this indicator provides information about the volume of community service work undertaken. The second part measures the efficiency of the service, showing how quickly criminal justice services are helping those convicted to complete their orders.

#### *Points to bear in mind*

Community service tends to be more effective the shorter the time required to complete the hours ordered by the court. However, it is also important that councils match the programme of community service to the needs and abilities of the client. Unless the service programme is of a suitable quality it is unlikely that the order will be successful in reducing re-offending. There will, therefore be occasions when it is inappropriate to work through the order too quickly.
