#### School occupancy

1: a) The percentage of primary schools where the ratio of pupils to places is:

- 40% or less
- 41-60%
- 61-80%
- 81-100%
- 101% or more.

b) The total number of primary schools

#### *What the indicator reports*

This indicator shows the proportion of each council's primary schools within the four occupancy bands shown.

The occupancy level is a measure of how many of the places available for pupils in a school have been taken up. For example, if a school has 150 places and 120 are filled, the occupancy level is 80%. Each council determines the number of places that are available in its schools.

#### *Points to bear in mind*

The calculation of occupancy level depends on the way in which a school's capacity is determined. Councils have some discretion in this area and there may, therefore, be minor differences between the ways they determine capacity. Some of the factors which may be important are:

- whether or not gymnasiums are counted as teaching rooms
- how non-teaching rooms are treated
- the treatment of rooms used for only part of the curriculum
- whether surplus accommodation is given over to community and other use and is no longer treated as available for school use.

The variation in the number of primary schools among councils means that a small percentage of schools in a large council may represent more schools than a high percentage in a small council.

2: a) The percentage of secondary schools where the ratio of pupils to places is:

- 40% or less
- 41-60%
- 61-80%
- 81-100%
- 101% or more.

b) The total number of secondary schools

#### *What the indicator reports*

This indicator shows the proportion of each council's secondary schools within the four bands shown.

The occupancy level is a measure of how many of the places available for pupils in a school have been taken up. For example, if there are 800 places and 600 are filled, the occupancy level is 75%. Each council determines the number of places that are available in its schools.

#### *Points to bear in mind*

The calculation of occupancy level depends on the way in which a school's capacity is determined. Councils have some discretion in this area and there may, therefore, be minor

differences between the ways they determine capacity. Some of the factors which may be important are:

- whether or not gymnasiums are counted as teaching rooms
- how non-teaching rooms are treated
- the treatment of rooms used for only part of the curriculum
- whether surplus accommodation is given over to community and other use and is no longer treated as available for school use.

The variation in the number of secondary schools between councils means that a small percentage of schools in a large council may represent more schools than a high percentage in a small council.

#### ***What the indicator reports***

The delivery of quality services is dependent on a trained and motivated workforce and it is, therefore essential that councils' employment policies reflect their commitment to equal opportunities. The indicator provides a picture of the current gender balance in promoted teaching posts, in relation to the overall gender balance within the profession in different types of school.

The indicator does not deal with equalities relating to ethnicity, disability or sexual orientation.

#### ***Points to bear in mind***

The indicator includes all posts involved in direct teaching in a school, providing teaching services directly to pupils/students. This includes peripatetic teachers, support for learning teachers, visiting specialists, home tutors, guidance teachers, assistant head teachers, deputy head teachers and head teachers.

### Children's panel liaison

- 4: **Social background reports:**
- a) **the number of reports submitted to the Reporter during the year**
  - b) **the proportion of reports requested by the Reporter which were submitted within target time.**

#### ***What the indicator reports***

This indicator shows how well councils are meeting the national standard times for submitting social background reports to the Reporter. In 2005/06 these targets were changed by agreement between the Scottish Children's Reporter Administration (SCRA) and the Association of Directors of Social Work to be 20 days for initial assessment reports and 25 days for social background reports. The extent to which the performance of councils can be compared with that of previous years is, therefore, very limited.

### **Points to bear in mind**

The SCRA records detailed information on the number of reports it receives from each council and the proportion received within the appropriate target time. Councils are provided with this information but in a few cases have local systems for monitoring their own performance which provide a different interpretation from that of the SCRA.

The figures provided in this compendium are those provided by the SCRA and in a few cases may vary from those reported locally by individual councils.

### **5: Supervision:**

- a) the number of new supervision requirements made during the year
- b) the proportion of children seen by a supervising officer within 15 days.

### **What the indicator reports**

This indicator shows how well councils are meeting the national target time for allocating a social worker (supervising officer) and arranging for a visit to the child/family to take place as the first step in the programme of work with the child.

The National Standard is that "the local authority will give effect to supervision requirements with no condition of residence within 15 days of date of issue by the children's hearing"

### **Points to bear in mind**

The indicator **excludes** those cases where the hearing imposes a condition of residence on the child. That is, where the child is placed in some form of residential establishment or required to stay at a specific address away from home (eg. with a grandparent).

## **Looked after children**

### **6: Academic attainment. The number and percentage of young people of age 16 or 17, ceasing to be looked after away from home, who achieved SCQF level 3 or better in English and Maths or other subjects:**

### **What the indicator reports**

This indicator reflects how well councils meet the targets established by the Scottish Executive and provide for the educational needs of young people in their care who are looked after away from home.

This indicator refers only to those young people who ceased to be cared for during the year who were 16 or 17 years of age.

### **Points to bear in mind**

The Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework (SCQF) encompasses a wider range of qualifications than the 'Standard Grade' on which this indicator had previously been based.

The Scottish Executive has established a target that for the educational attainment of young people leaving care stemming from milestone 8 in '*Social Justice: a Scotland where everyone matters*' where they identify that young people should have achieved both English and Maths at SCQF level 3.

- 7: Staff qualifications: The percentage of care staff with appropriate qualifications for the level of post held, working in local authority residential children's homes.**

### ***What the indicator reports***

The extent to which care staff have appropriate qualifications for the post they hold is one of a number of factors which contribute to the quality of residential care, but it is significant. This indicator identifies the extent to which professional staff working in council care homes for children are appropriately qualified.

### ***Points to bear in mind***

Professional staff working in care homes are now required to register with the Scottish Social Services Council (SSSC) and to demonstrate that they hold appropriate qualification for the level of post they occupy. Staff have until 2008 to register and, where necessary, increase their level of qualification to that required for their post.

This is the first year of reporting for this indicator which will be affected by:

- the availability of suitably qualified staff
- national guidance to councils on staff qualification from the SSSC.

The indicator relates only to staff in care homes managed by councils. Voluntary and private sector homes are not included.

- 8: Privacy: The number of single rooms and the number of rooms with en-suite facilities, expressed as a percentage of all residential care places for children, used by the council.**

### ***What the indicator reports***

Research on the preferences of residents in residential establishments shows that privacy is of particular importance. Therefore, the indicator measures this particular aspect of the quality of the residential care.

The indicator is based on the number of bedrooms intended solely for one person, and excludes rooms which have two or more beds but are used by only one person.

En-suite facilities will have as a minimum a shower or bath in the apartment for the sole use of the resident. It should be recognised that many homes, but not all, will provide a higher standard than this.

### ***Points to bear in mind***

The indicator is likely to be affected by:

- limitations in the resources available to councils and the owners of homes in the voluntary and private sectors to improve homes by increasing the number of single rooms
  - the physical layout of an existing home, which may limit the scope for creating single rooms
  - design standards for new homes which encourage greater provision of single rooms
- it is desirable for councils to use some double rooms to accommodate young siblings.

#### ***What the indicator reports***

Respite care is a service intended to benefit a carer and the child he or she cares for by providing a short break from caring tasks. This performance indicator measures a key element of support for carers. This indicator only concerns respite care provided or purchased by the council, or by voluntary organisations funded for this purpose by the council.

Respite care breaks may last a few hours or a few weeks and may or may not be repeated at regular intervals. The duration of the service episode must allow the carer a break from caring tasks; for this reason a minimum duration of one hour is required for the service episode to count as respite for the purposes of this performance indicator (normally, the duration of the respite episode will be longer). The carer may use the break for any non-caring activity he or she chooses. Services that provide additional care alongside the care provided by the carer (to the same or another cared-for person) provide assistance but do not provide a respite break.

The indicator reports on both the volume of respite provided and the extent to which that respite is provided outwith 'institutional' settings.

#### ***Points to bear in mind***

The indicator will be affected primarily by:

- the pattern of need and services required
- the availability of respite care.
